## JURORS

### SUSANNAH HART THOMER, PWS, PWCS, BWS

Susannah Hart Thomer has a Bachelor of Fine Arts in fashion illustration from Moore College of Art in Philadelphia and is a signature member of the Philadelphia Water Color Society, Pennsylvania Water Color Society, and Baltimore Water Color Society. She has illustrated children's books, has won various awards in local and national watercolor exhibitions, and was recently featured in an 8-page article in American Artist Magazine.

Susannah also belongs to several art leagues and groups and currently volunteers as newsletter editor for the Greater Norristown Art League. She is represented in art galleries in Pennsylvania, New Jersey, and Delaware. Susannah has won many awards, including the PWCS Board of Directors Award at the 2011 PWCS International Anniversary Show.

### MICHAEL ADAMS, PWCS

Michael Adams is a painter and sculptor. He is recognized for his portraits of birds in watercolor, acrylic, and stone sculpture. The former Senior Designer at Lenox Collections, he is an active designer in the collectible industry and has illustrated numerous children's books.

As a fine artist, his focus has been wildlife and landscape painting. He participates in local and regional exhibitions. Michael is formerly the president of the Greater Norristown Art League, where he teaches watercolor and sculpture classes. He also teaches in the Illustration department at The University of the Arts in Philadelphia.

Recently, Michael was commissioned to paint a historical/patriotic mural for the town of Jersey Shore, PA and was the featured wildlife artist in the John James Audubon Gallery at Mills Grove Sanctuary in Audubon.

## THIRD ANNUAL JURIED ART SHOW CATEGORIES

- A. PAINTING: WATERCOLOR/GOUACHE/TEMPERA
- B. PAINTING: OIL/ACRYLIC/PASTEL
- C. GRAPHIC ART: Including Drawings (pencil, charcoal, pen & ink, etc.) and original Hand-pulled Prints
- D. SCULPTURE: Three-dimensional or bas-relief artwork done in clay, paper, wood, metal, or stone)
- E. PHOTOGRAPHY: Traditional or Digitally enhanced camera image photographed by the artist. Image must be purely photographic or digitally enhanced without the addition of any non-photo imagery or additional media.
- F. OTHER MEDIA: Mixed Media, Collage, Computer-generated Art, manipulated photography/digital imagery that incorporates other forms of image mark-making other than pure photography.

## RULES

1. ENTRY FEE: \$10 entry fee for initial entry; \$5 for additional entry. (Limit 2 entries and 5 Sales Portfolio pieces – see definitions below.) Meadowood residents and staff will not be charged an entry fee. All juried artwork must remain in place until the end of the show on Sunday. NO EXCEPTIONS.
2. SALES PORTFOLIOS, up to 5 pieces per artist, must be matted and completely wrapped with a clear protective covering. Portfolio pieces will not be judged but will be for sale and prominently displayed. Show tags for portfolio pieces are available on the attached sheet. Show tags must be attached to the back on the outside of the protective covering.
3. TWO DIMENSIONAL works must be properly framed and wired. Sawtooth hangers will NOT be accepted. Artwork dimensions may not exceed 36" in ANY dimension, including frame. NO multi-part works will be accepted, unless all parts are in one frame that does not exceed the size requirement.
4. THREE DIMENSIONAL works, which are not free standing, must be securely attached to a base. Show Committee will not assemble any objects or materials and reserves the right to reject any work that requires an inordinate amount of difficulty in handling.
5. JURIED PIECES: Only original artwork will be allowed. Copies or reproductions will NOT be accepted, nor will art derived from other artists' works or published/printed sources or photographs not originated by submitting artist. Artwork that has had significant criticism and/or reworking or retouching by instructors - and artwork derived from workshops with significant guidance are not considered "original." Photography taken by the artist and computer-enhanced by the artist to the degree attainable by traditional photographic techniques will be permitted and considered Photography. Any image that has been digitally modified beyond the scope of traditional methods will be considered Computer-Generated Art.
6. PORTFOLIO PIECES: May be originals or signed and numbered limited edition reproductions. Photocopies NOT allowed.
7. All work must be for sale or marked NFS (not for sale). No POR (price on request) will be allowed. MEADOWOOD will retain a 20% donation on the sale of all artwork.
8. While the utmost care will be taken in handling of all artwork, MEADOWOOD DOES NOT ASSUME RESPONSIBILITY FOR ANY ARTWORK.
9. The show committee reserves the right to reject any artwork not meeting all of the above rules, or any work they deem inappropriate or unsuitable for exhibition in the Meadowood Show.

Deliver art work on Tuesday, March 27<sup>th</sup> from 9-11 AM or 5-7 PM to Meadowood's Strasburg Auditorium in the Schultz Community Center. Your Registration Form should have been completed along with the art work properly tagged prior to arrival. Unaccepted work must be picked up on Thursday, March 29<sup>th</sup> from 10 AM to noon. **ALL UNSOLD WORK MUST BE PICKED UP AND SIGNED OUT ON SUNDAY, APRIL 1<sup>ST</sup> AT 4:00 PM!** There is no storage facility; a charge of \$5/day will be assessed for each piece not retrieved by this time.
